If you have any questions regarding the Club or would like to arrange a visit to the Club please do not hesitate to contact us.

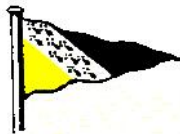

Note 2: Members bringing additional boats for use at any time of the year must notify the Office for allocation of buoys and moorings. Additional fees are payable.

Note 3: All boats remaining on Club premises after 1st December 2018 will be charged pro rata at the appropriate fees until removed, unless winter storage has been applied for.

Note 4: Members requiring winter storage must complete a separate application and send to the Office with the appropriate fees.

Note 5: All craft kept at the Club (including all launching trolleys and road trailers) MUST be marked with the owners name for identification purposes.

Note 6: It is the owner's responsibility to inform the Office of meter readings at the point of mooring up and departing your pen.
