FRIDAY 30th JULY

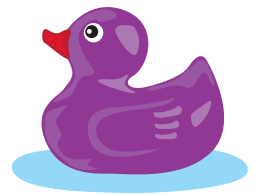
Friday is all about **Duck Racing, Pizza, Movies and Popcorn.**

MOORINGS – Please vacate all Visitors Quay and Short Jetty moorings by 9am each morning. Please note: all Visitors Quay and Short Jetty moorings are reserved for Regatta Party ticket holders only on the evening of Saturday 31st July.

BAR & LICENSING RULES – No person may consume alcohol on Club Premises* if under 18 years of age. All persons under 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult whilst in the bar, except when purchasing food and non-alcoholic beverages. Under 18s are not allowed in the bar lounge after 9pm.

Pushchairs and the like are only permitted in the bar if sufficient room is available and they do not cause an obstruction. Fire exits must be kept clear at all times.

Full bar closing times are shown in the Club programme and have been set by the Management Committee. The Clubroom will close 30 minutes after the bar closes.

Should you have any queries please raise them with a Flag Officer or Committee Member in the first instance.
